



Technical Officer - Tangambalanga

As Indigo FM is a collective of Radio Stations, it is proposed to have a Technical Officer at each station site.

The Technical Officer will be primarily responsible for:

- Overseeing the Tangambalanga station's ability to transmit in a professional manner at all times.

Reporting responsibilities:

- Liaise with the CoM via the President or Secretary as required.
- Report to the Tech-Programming Sub-Committee Co-ordinator re matters of need.
- Providing a quarterly update to Tech-Programming Sub-Committee.
- It is expected that the Technical Officer will have an understanding of and commitment to Indigo FM's aims and objectives and promote that Indigo FM is a co-operative broadcasting service, serving many areas (ie not just a localised service).

The key tasks involved in the role include:

- Working co-operatively with volunteers, staff and visitors.
- Undertaking presenter training in conjunction with the Local Site Co-ordinator.
- Assess the serviceability and capabilities of technical / technological assets at the site and recommend repair, replacement, modification or upgrades as appropriate.
- Plan maintenance and modification programs for technical / technological assets of the Station in conjunction with the Tech-Programming Sub-Committee.
- Advise the Tech-Programming Sub-Committee on the need for changes to the configuration of technical / technological assets of the station.

Prospective applicants will be required to obtain a Working With Children Check within 4 weeks of commencing in the role. This is free for volunteers.
